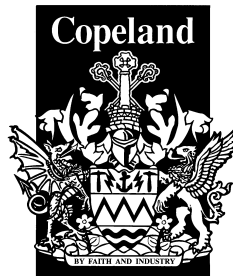

## i) INTRODUCTION

The text and maps published as the “2<sup>nd</sup> Deposit Version” of the Local Plan incorporate a number of material changes to its predecessor, the 1<sup>st</sup> Deposit Version (February 2004). In the text these are readily apparent as a) words or sections it is proposed to delete shown with a strike through (eg ~~delete~~) and b) new words or sections proposed as amendments or additions printed in red and underlined. The maps, located in a pocket in the rear cover of the Plan, show all the boundary or allocation changes on an OS map base. The reader must refer to the original, full colour maps in the 1<sup>st</sup> Deposit Version for all the locational material which it is not proposed to change at this stage.

This schedule identifies the material text changes to policies and paragraphs (according to the appropriate reference number and in Plan-order) and indicates the reason for the change. The reasons are of four types:

- 1) **Updating** – alterations to references and tenses which reflect the move from 1<sup>st</sup> Deposit Version (February 2004) to 2<sup>nd</sup> Deposit Version (April 2005). These are all fairly self evident and indicated with a **U**.
- 2) **Remodelled Policies** – alteration to the wording of policies in accordance with best practice guidance such that the meaning remains the same but the sense is clarified. Also to meet amendments proposed in reports G1 - G3 on improved policy wording. Indicated with an asterisk: \*
- 3) **Response to Objections** – where deletions and/or amendments are proposed to meet objections made to the 1<sup>st</sup> Deposit Version of the Plan. The justification for such changes is set out in a number of Council reports which are available for reference alongside the 2<sup>nd</sup> Deposit Version of the Plan and this schedule. These are referenced **D1, D2, ..., H1, H2 ...**, etc based on the following:

- 4) **Sustainability Appraisal** – all the policies in 1D and 2D have been subject to a Sustainability Appraisal which has also included proposed changes to text.

Notes:

- The schedule does not include all paragraph and Policy re numbering or revised cross references which arise from other changes to the text
- Reference to 1<sup>st</sup> Deposit Version = 1D
- Reference to 2<sup>nd</sup> Deposit Version = 2D
- The sections iii) Settlement Boundary Changes and v) Housing Allocations are each set out as an index providing references to the relevant Council report.
- Section xii) is an index to the Proposals Map Changes in the order they appear in the rear-cover pocket. Again each includes a reference to the relevant Council report.
- LPWP stands for Local Plan Working Party composed of 8 Borough Councillors who assessed all the reports on objections, the Sustainability Appraisal and other changes in detail. They made recommendations to Full Council and where necessary these are referred to by a Minute reference and date of the particular meeting.
